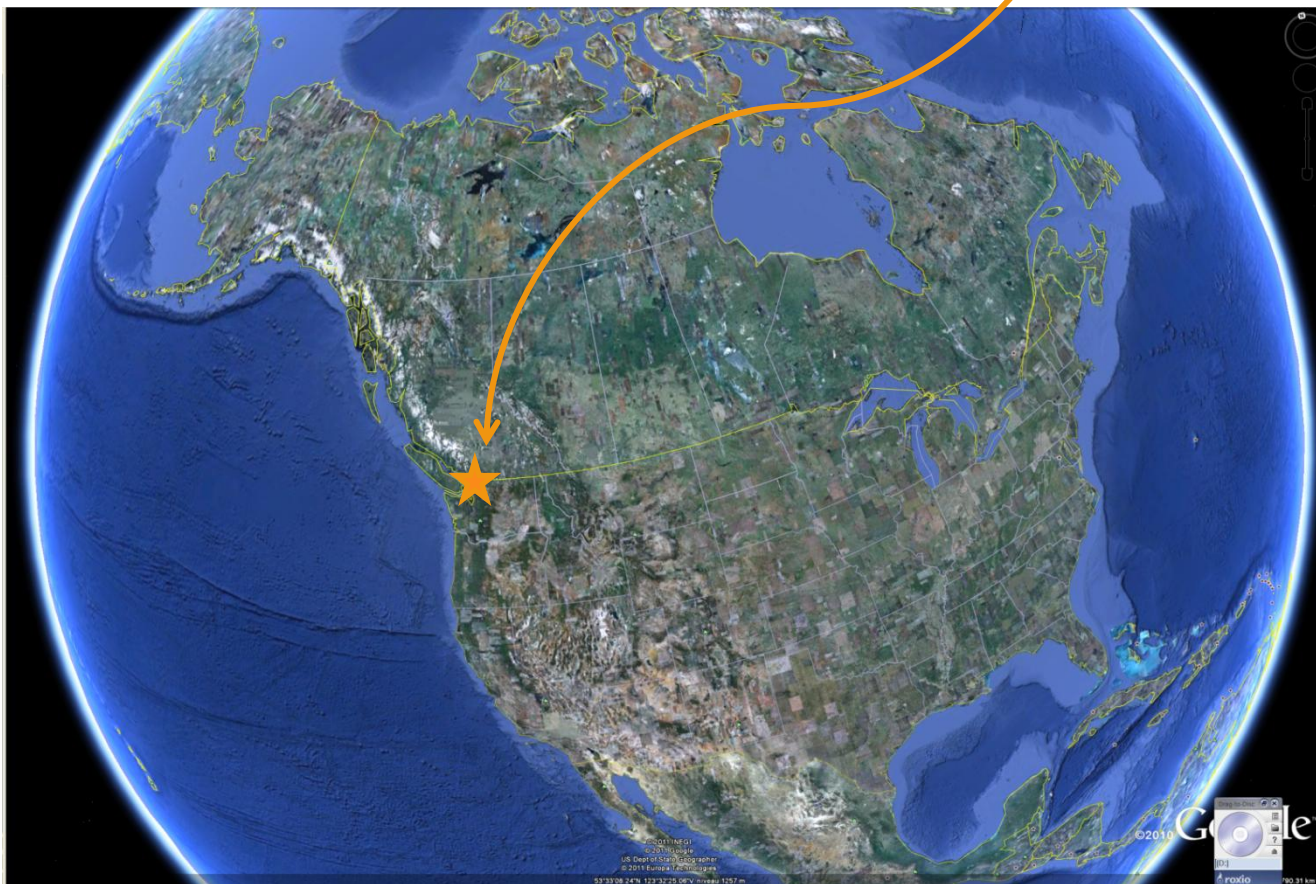

## Salt Building & Habitat Island



### **Salt Building (South East False Creek Village)**

The Salt Building is a very significant landmark in the Southeast False Creek neighborhood. It's a heritage listed building located in the heart of the community on the NW corner of First Avenue and Manitoba Street, which was the original shoreline of False Creek.

The Salt Building, which was built around 1930 to refine raw salt and converted in the 1980s as a paper recycling plant, sat empty for a number of years.

The building is owned by the City of Vancouver and prior to the 2010 Winter Games, it was restored to include a foundation upgrade and basement. During the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Games, the building was used as the "athletes' living room". The Salt building is managed by the City's Real Estate Services Department.

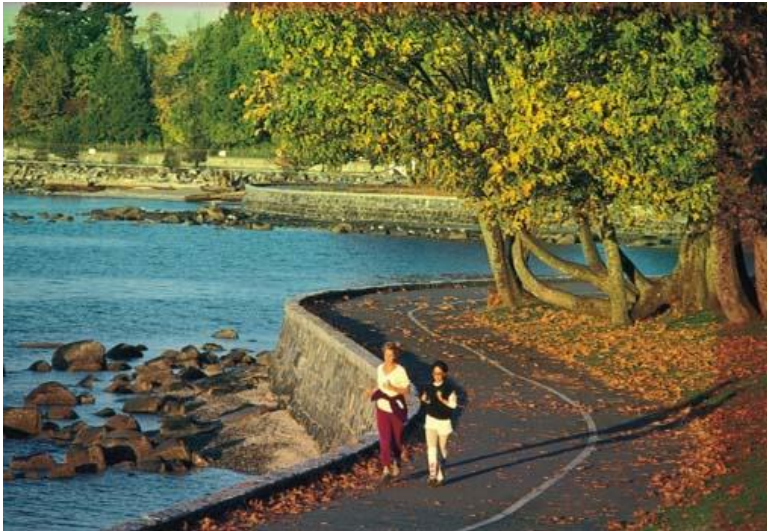
### **Habitat Island**

Habitat Island is an urban sanctuary along Southeast False Creek. Deep layers of soil have been added to the area to provide nourishment for new trees to grow. Boulders and logs commonly found along the coastlines in this region of British Columbia provide a home for plants, small animals, insects, crabs, starfish, barnacles and other creatures. Surrounded by water at high tide, the island is also a sanctuary for birds.

More than 200 native trees, as well as shrubs, flowers, and grasses that grow naturally in this region have been planted along the waterfront path and on the island.

# Program

## Stanley Park



**Stanley Park** is the largest urban park in Canada. Stanley Park covers an area of 404.9 hectares covered with forests. It is more than 10% larger than New York City's Central Park and almost half the size of London's Richmond Park. The park attracts an estimated eight million visitors every year, including locals and tourists, who come for its recreational facilities and its natural attributes.

## Gas Town



**Gastown, Vancouver's oldest neighbourhood**, is the epicentre of the urban revolution. Block upon block of grand Victorian buildings hold memories of Gastown's reign as Canada's third-largest city and one of the most cosmopolitan. Today, these Old World aesthetics prove a glorious backdrop for today's urban lifestyle.

Gastown is one of Vancouver's most hip and distinctive shopping and lifestyle neighbourhoods with over 180 shops, restaurants, bars, cafes and clubs. Gastown is the hub of creative talent, independent businesses, award winning bars and restaurants and fashion forward boutiques.
